Overview:

As we seek to share the new life that is found in Christ, the following guidelines and policies promote unity and understanding between parents and Children's Ministry volunteers. Thank you for the privilege of caring for your children!

We provide nursery care to the following groups during Sunday worship services:

- ★ Infants (8 weeks to walkers)
- ★ Ages 1-2

Children ages 3-1st grade will be dismissed to attend Children's Church, if you wish, following the offertory hymn.



Food:

Please label all belongings, including sippy cups and snack containers. A light snack is provided for all classes except infants. If your child has allergies, please notify the Nursery coordinator and make note of it on your child's information card.

Security:

Each family is given a family number in case a parent is needed in the Nursery. If your number appears on the screen in the front of the sanctuary, please see a nursery worker.

Parents are issued security tags which MUST be presented when picking up your child. Nursery volunteers will only release your child with a security tag or the authorization of a Children's Ministry staff member.

Your child may cry when you drop him or her in the nursery. In most cases, the child will stop crying within 10-15 minutes. If the child is inconsolable, however, we will page you.



Health:

Children exhibiting the following signs within the past 24 hours cannot be admitted to the Nursery: diarrhea, vomiting, fever, rash, open sores, runny nose (other than clear). If a child exhibits these symptoms, the parents will be paged.



Visitors and First-time Parents:

Please fill out an Information Card for your child. Be sure you receive a family number which may be used to page you, should your child need mom or dad.

Visitors will be issued a temporary security tag which you should return to a nursery volunteer when you pick up your child. If you decide to make Midtown your church home, we will be happy to issue you a permanent family number and security tag.
